AMA Criteria for Impairment Arising from Disturbances in Consciousness or Awareness

Overview: The level of impairment associated with disturbances in the level of consciousness or awareness can be estimated based on the AMA criteria.

Parameters:

- (1) changes in level of consciousness or awareness
- (2) limitation in performance of activities of daily living (ADL)

Alteration in Level of Consciousness or Awareness	Limitation in ADL	Percent Whole Person Impairment
none	none	0%
brief repetitive or persistent alteration of state of consciousness	minimal	0 – 14%
brief repetitive or persistent alteration of state of consciousness	moderate	15 – 39%
prolonged alteration of state of consciousness	severe	40 – 69%
irreversible coma or semicoma requiring artificial support	incapacitated (completely dependent)	70 – 90%
